Description:

The morning celebration was presided by Jorge Luis Perdomo Di-Lela, Communications Minister, and Ana Julia Marine López and Rafael Solís, Communications Vice Ministers. In addition, General and Ministerial Directors, the General Secretary of the Communist Party Committee, the General Secretary of the Cuban Young Communist League, and members of the Work Bureau, also attended this ceremony.
