

Application process

WSA is an awards system based on nomination. The project must be registered on the platform: https://db.icnm.net/Signup/WSA/2020/ [2]

Application deadline: August 31, 2020

You must create a user on this platform and then carry out the registering process of the project.

The WSA national expert will only nominate one (1) national digital application in each one of the 8 categories. Each country can only propose one project per category.
