Main event for Radiocuba's 25th Anniversary

In the afternoon of October 1st, the main event for the 25th Anniversary of the creation of the Enterprise Radiocuba took place in the theater of the Ministry of Communications, and a postal stamp was canceled by officials and leaders from the Central Committee of the Cuban Communist Party (PCC), the Council of State and Ministers, and from the institution itself. This ceremony was broadcast through video conference to the whole country and all social distancing measures were respected as part of the fight against the COVID-19 pandemic.

As a recount, the summary video was projected with the last works of Radiocuba for making progress in the program of implementation of Digital Television in Cuba, coverage of silence zones and the development of other services amidst COVID-19.

The celebration became a day of recognition when Alba Estévanez Novo, member of the National Secretariat of the Union read the document for the presentation of the 80th Anniversary Stamp of the CTC, and invited Guilarte de Nacimiento to do it.

Plasencia Castro, GEIC's main director, also delivered the keynote speech. The cultural activity was brought about by Duo Iris.
