

On March 3, the Minister of Communications, Mayra Arevich Marín, accompanied by the president of Etecsa, Tania Velázquez Rodríguez; the director of the Havana branch and other executives, visited the work in progress at the 70 and 23 Minipoint of the Cuban Telecommunications Company (ETECSA).
